Assessment

All assessments are competency-based. Students are required to complete written and practical tasks during these courses, which reflect the requirements of the relevant unit of competency and current workplace practices.

Completed and submitted work will be assessed within ten (10) working days, and feedback provided as soon as possible thereafter. Where the student's work is assessed to be not yet satisfactory, they will be provided with additional feedback, coaching or tutoring, and the opportunity to resubmit their work with a view to having it assessed as satisfactory.

Feedback and information regarding the student's competency, progress, and study will be provided by the facilitator on a regular and ongoing basis. Ongoing support is also available to all learners and will be provided as soon as a need is identified.



Student Support
